Hawai'i Supreme Court Certifies Goodsill Attorney Johnathan C. Bolton in Business Bankruptcy Law

(Honolulu, Hawai'i — November 26, 2012) — Johnathan C. Bolton received a certificate of specialization in business bankruptcy law from the Supreme Court of Hawai'i. Bolton is the first attorney to receive this distinction in Hawai'i.
