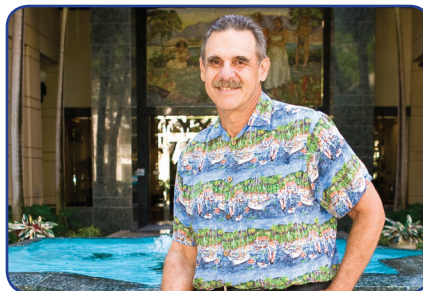


Attorneys and staff representing Goodsill's 150 person Ohana.
